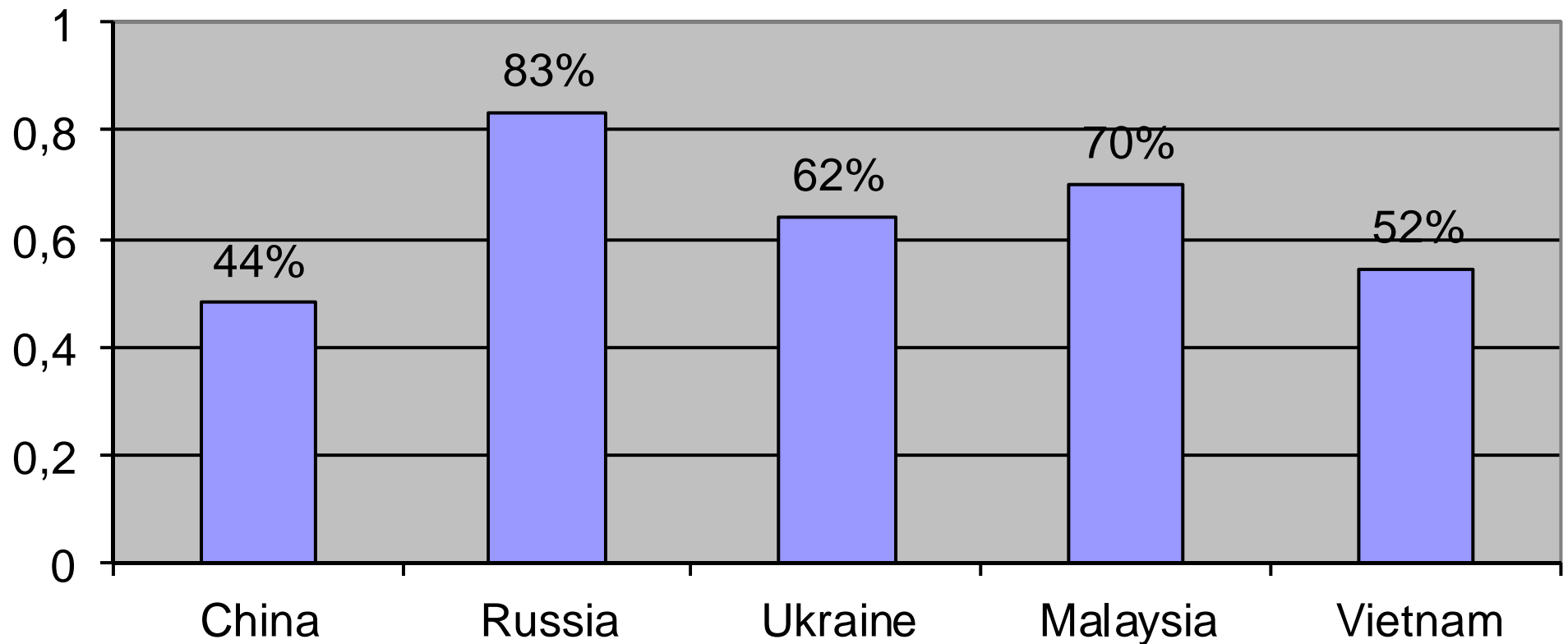

(the **highest** in all of Europe)

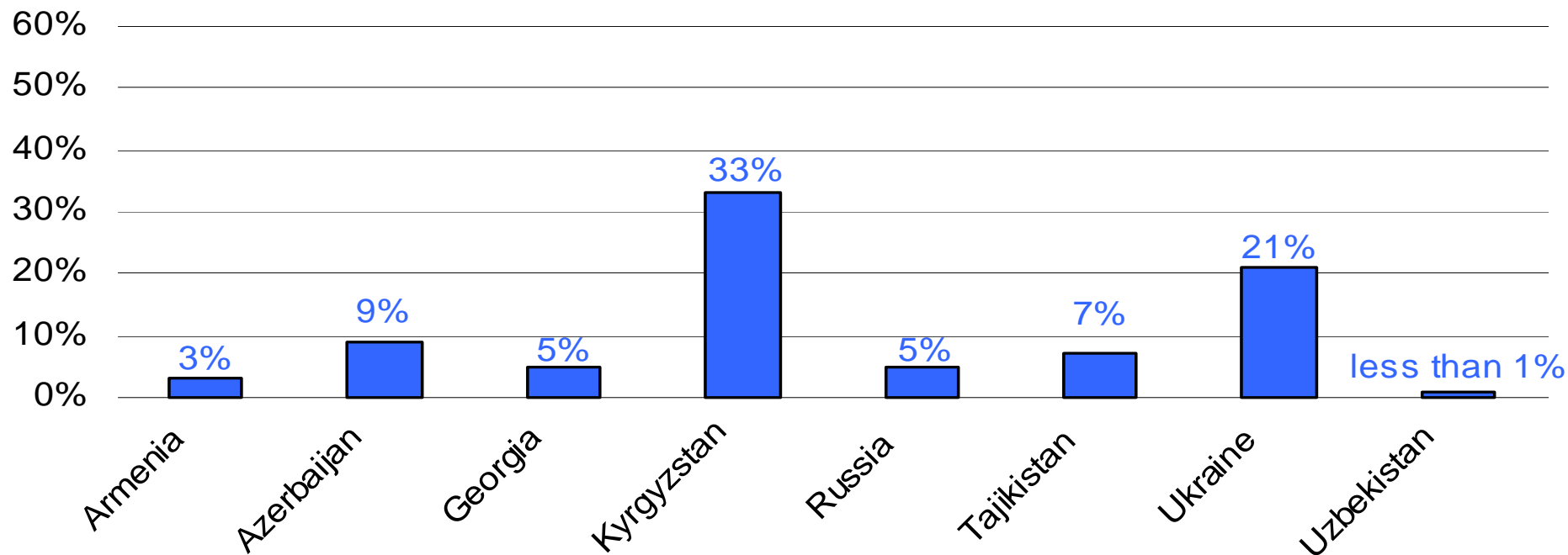

Øst: Antal IDUs i kontakt med sprøjteprogrammer December 2005



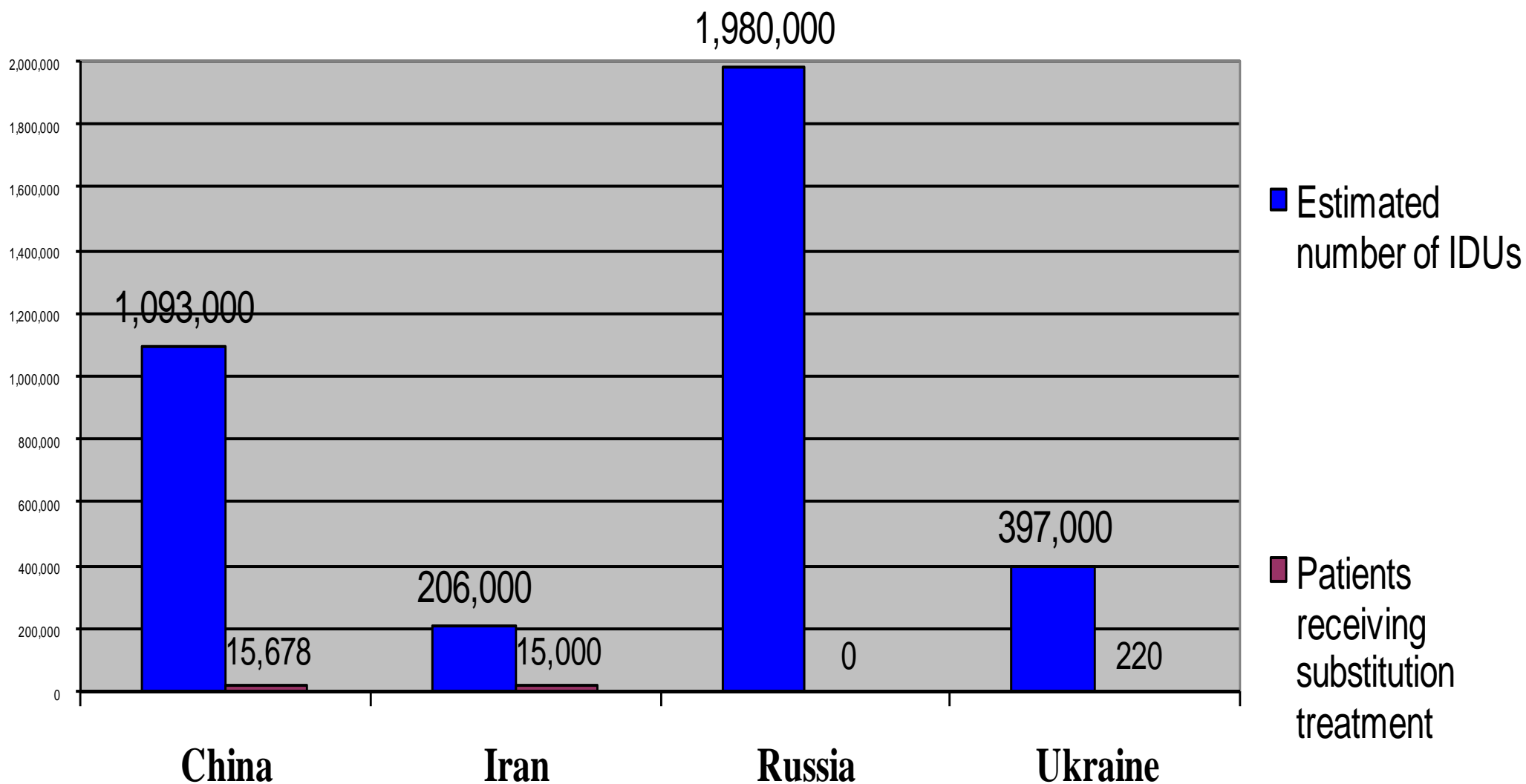

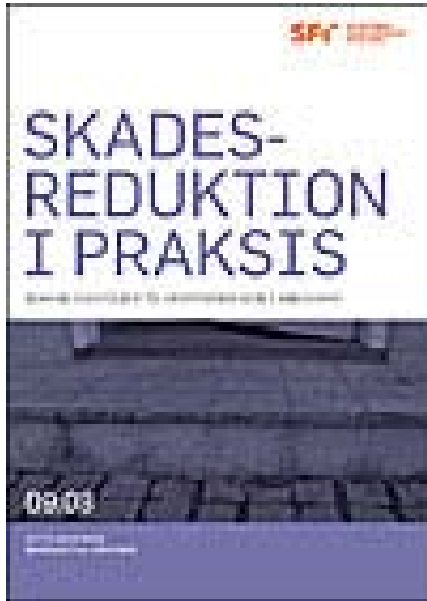

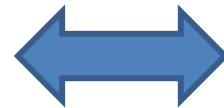
